Local and National Strong

Options PRC was established almost 30 years ago with the purpose of addressing the needs of women facing a pregnancy for which they hadn't planned. We are an independently operating pregnancy resource center with two locations, one in Corvallis and one in Albany. From these two offices, we serve women primarily in Linn and Benton Counties. Having local individuals – staff, volunteers and Board – making decisions at a local level helps us deliver better services to the women in the communities in which we live and work.



Options PRC also networks with other pregnancy centers in our state. As an executive Director, it's valuable to me to be able to draw upon the expertise of others who serve in a similar role in their community. It can be challenging at times to manage a ministry that also seems to catch the attention of organizations like Planned Parenthood. If you've been part of the Options family for a while, you no doubt are aware of legislative activity that we've lobbied against. Activity from organizations like Planned Parenthood and the National Abortion Rights Action League (NARAL) have resulted in Oregon Senate and House bills being proposed that would deeply affect how we do our work.

With the legislative activity affecting all the pregnancy centers operations in our state, we have found it beneficial to network together on a regular basis. Last September we held our first statewide mini Summit. Pregnancy center employees, volunteers and Board members from around the state gathered in Salem and spent a day networking, praising God and sharing a meal together. We also formed the Oregon Pregnancy Center Association (OPCA) with a vote that day. The OPCA, along with networking opportunities, will provide an avenue for us to communicate and mobilize quickly if needed to defend the work of our local pregnancy centers.

One additional level of networking and support we use is at the national level. Options PRC is part of a larger network of pregnancy centers through affiliating with Heartbeat International and the National Institute of Family and Life Advocates (NIFLA). These national organizations provide training and support for us. We subscribe to a common Commitment of Care of our clients. For a nominal annual affiliation fee, Options PRC has access to all kinds of helpful resources, including legal expertise.

Having a local organization has its advantages, but we really can't succeed without the bigger picture. Pregnancy Centers all over this country are helping women at their most critical point of making a decision about an unplanned pregnancy. The types of services offered at each center can vary, as each local center determines the best way to provide help. But it's reassuring to know we are part of a larger network that cares about the larger picture.

I don't think I can conclude without asking you to consider your involvement with Options PRC, the local organization that addresses life-critical issues each day we open the doors for business. We see heartbreak, for sure, but we see miracles so often. Don't let fear of the unknown keep you from being used by God in a mighty way and receive some amazing blessings!
